AVRUTINE: Thank you, Supervisor. 16 Appearing for the applicants, Howard 17 Avrutine, 575 Underhill Boulevard, Syosset. 18 This is application is for Fore 19 Improvement Corp. and K&D Ventures, Inc. d/b/a 2.0 C&B Archery for a special use permit to operate an 21 archery center with an accessory retail store. 22 The premises on the application is 23 located at the westerly end of Commercial Street 24 613.06 feet west of New South Street. The street address is 11 Commercial Street. It is zoned LI, 25

light industrial district. It's also known as Section 46, Block Q, Lot 235 on the Nassau County Land and Tax map. Fore Improvement Corp. is the owner of the premises. K&D Ventures, Inc. is the operator of the facility and is pursuant to a lease with the owner. The term expires in approximately ten years.

As the Board can see from the site plan that has been submitted, there are two buildings on the parcel both of which were constructed in 1961 which are legal for uses authorized in the LI, industrial zoning district.

This application concerns only the building on the northwest portion of the premises. The building has one story and consists of 12,650 square feet of floor area. The site is fully compliant with respect to parking with 70 spaces required and 71 spaced provided.

The floor plan to the building depicts the existing condition of the premises. There is a range area, a retail area which sells archery equipment and accessories as well as some office space, bathrooms and storage areas.

I have photographs that I took depicting the premises for what the conditions are,

5 1 if I can hand those in. 2 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: Is there a 3 similar operation of this nature anywhere in close proximity on the Island? 4 5 MR. AVRUTINE: Out east, Smithtown, and It's not common, but this facility -- I 6 7 will get to it in a few moments -- has a lot of 8 involvement with Cub scouts, Boy Scouts, schools, 9 summer camps. It's a very community-oriented 10 business. 11 The hours of operation are Tuesday 12 through Thursday 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Friday 13 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m, Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 14 6:00 p.m., Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mondays 15 they are closed, but, likely, they'll be opened on 16 Mondays in the future, if they should change. 17 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: You said Tuesday 18 through Thursday? 19 MR. AVRUTINE: Tuesday, Wednesday, 20 Thursday 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. And they have 21 leagues, junior leagues which are ages 8 through 22 17. 23 The leagues are on Saturday and Sunday 24 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and Thursday evenings

from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Fortunately, for this

6 1 operation, the busiest times are on the weekends 2 and evenings when the other businesses in the 3 industrial area and surrounding industrial area are 4 closed. 5 They have two full-time employees in 6 addition to the owner. There are two to three 7 instructors on the floor at all times and all 8 instructors are certified in archery. 9 COUNCILMAN MACAGNONE: Are they 10 certified in first aid and safety? 11 This is Ralph Allocca. MR. AVRUTINE: 12 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: Just come to the 1.3 podium, only because the hearing is being 14 videotaped and audiotaped. 15 MR. ALLOCCA: I, myself, am certified 16 in the use of the AED and first aid. I have my 17 other instructor. He is -- I'm a level two 18 instructor in archery. My other instructor is a 19 level two instructor. 2.0 COUNCILMAN MACAGNONE: There will 21 always be someone on premises with that skill? 22 MR. ALLOCCA: Yes. 23 COUNCILMAN MACAGNONE: There will be 24 tournaments there? 25 MR. AVRUTINE: Yes, they'll have

7 1 tournaments and leagues and essentially promote --2 archery is a skill. 3 COUNCILMAN MACAGNONE: I think it's 4 wonderful. 5 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: Ralph, if I put an apple on my head --6 7 MR. ALLOCCA: No, actually we would --8 William Tell had do it with a crossbow and we tend 9 to go with Olympic -- actually, we have two 10 Olympians already. 11 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: That's not 12 something I should volunteer for? 13 MR. The retail store has all the equipment and 17 accessories. 18 SUPERVISOR VENDITTO: That completes 19 your application? 2.0 MR.
