# THE TOWN OF OYSTER BAY, A PLACE WHERE SENIORS LIVE, WORK, PLAY AND STAY

*Anyone 60 years of age and older is entitled to all benefits offered to senior citizens by the Town, except Golden Age Housing, which is age 62 and older.*

**TRIPS FOR SENIORS:** Town seniors can enjoy fantastic day trips, which have included local theaters, cruises on the great South Bay, holiday celebrations, and visits to Long Island's East End.

**TOWN OF OYSTER BAY GOLF COURSE:** Town seniors are able to enjoy reduced membership fees for the season and reduced greens fees on weekdays.

**TOWN SENIORS RECEIVE DISCOUNTS FOR:** Boat slip rentals, pool membership, and permanent shellfish permits.

**SENIOR BEACH ID CARD:** For a one-time nominal fee, seniors can purchase a lifetime *Senior Citizen Beach Identification Card*, entitling them to a free beach sticker each summer.

**FREE BOAT TRAILER PERMIT:** All Town seniors, with a *Senior Citizen Beach Identification Card*, are entitled to a free boat trailer permit each year.

**FREE SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM:** The Senior Summer Recreation program gives seniors a wonderful chance to socialize, create crafts, and play bingo, cards and games, as well as line dance and ballroom dance with live music. We also offer aquatic and exercise classes, tai chi, and yoga.

**COMPUTER SKILLS INSTRUCTION:** The SeniorNet Program, an educational course that teaches computer skills to residents 50 and older, is offered at the William P. Bennett Hicksville Community Center. Classes are administered by the Education & Assistance Corporation (EAC), who provide computer classes on a variety of topics, including basic computer knowledge, word processing and use of the Internet. **"GOLDEN AGE" HOUSING:** Provides high-quality, privately-owned, affordable cooperative units for seniors who meet income and residency requirements, making it possible to enjoy their later years in the Town they helped build. Call (516) 797-7935 for more information.

**HOUSING AUTHORITY:** An autonomous body responsible for the planning and housing of senior citizens who meet eligibility criteria. Call (516) 349-1000 for more information.

**HOME IMPROVEMENT ASSISTANCE:** Seniors age 60 and older, or residents who are physically challenged, may be eligible for weatherization, windows, doors, and/or roof, heat and/or hot water replacement. Call (516) 624-6177 for more information.

**TAX EXEMPTIONS:** Seniors meeting certain criteria may be eligible for certain tax breaks. For information on the following tax exemptions, contact the Nassau County Assessor's Office at (516) 571-1500.
