



For 2016, the Town of Oyster Bay's successful Nanny Membership will continue. This option allows non-residents, who provide individual day care for children, to purchase an individual, non-park district, resident membership. As a reminder, in order for the day care provider to qualify, the child's family must purchase a family membership, and the day-care provider must present a written statement from an adult in the child's family.

TOWN OF OYSTER BAY COMMUNITY PARK SWIM LESSONS

Classes are taught by American Red Cross Certified Lifeguards. Applications will be available at the Community Park Pools starting May 28, 2016 during the hours of pool registration and are available **TO REGISTERED POOL MEMBERS ONLY**. Children must be 5 years of age or older to participate. For each session, classes are held weekdays for two weeks. Each class begins either at 11am or Noon and lasts 45 minutes. The registration fee is \$50.00 per child for the first two-week session. If the same child signs up for additional two-week sessions, the fee will be \$25 per subsequent two-week session.

First Session: June 27 to July 8, 2016

(Postmark Deadline - June 20, 2016)

Second Session: July 11 to July 22, 2016

(Postmark Deadline - July 5, 2016)

Third Session: July 25 to August 5, 2016

(Postmark Deadline - July 18, 2016)

Fourth Session: August 8 to August 19, 2016

(Postmark Deadline - August 1, 2016)

TOWN OF OYSTER BAY SWIM TEAM

Meets at Marjorie Post and Syosset-Woodbury Pools.

Pool Members 6 to 16 years of age may join the TOB Swim Team for a chance to compete against other Nassau Municipal Swim Conference Teams. Participants should be able to swim two laps in good form.

The program (approximately 8-weeks) costs \$50 per swimmer (\$25 for each additional swimmer in the same family).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) who is responsible for the children and their behavior while at the pool.
2. A person must be 16 years of age or older to join as an individual member.
3. A "family" is defined as a married couple or single parent and all unmarried children residing at the same address.
4. Bathers must wear swimsuits and/or proper pool attire at all times while on the pool deck. Street shoes are not permitted on the pool deck.
5. Bathers are required to take showers before entering the pool.
6. Anyone wearing diapers in the pool must have a water repellent covering over them.
7. Persons using the pool, diving boards and other amenities must be capable and qualified to do so. Skill level, age and physical condition are factors to be considered. Lifeguards on duty reserve the right to make any final determinations.
8. In case of an emergency, notify the facility operator and contact help as soon as possible.
9. The following are prohibited in the pool area: ball playing of any type, pushing, running, dunking or boisterous conduct, toys, play equipment, swim fins, masks, glassware or breakables of any kind, radios, sun tan lotions or oils, and dressing or undressing, except in designated areas. Permitted flotation devices are limited to those sewn into the suit. No flotation devices with clips, buckles, belts, inflatables, etc. will be allowed.
10. Smoking and consumption of alcohol are PROHIBITED at all Town of Oyster Bay Parks, including pools.
11. EATING ON THE POOL DECK IS PROHIBITED, except in designated areas.
12. The Commissioner of Parks, or his designee, may adopt additional rules, regulations and hours of operation that he/she finds to be in the best interest of, or necessary for the safety of, the public.
13. The pool may be used only during posted hours of operation.
14. All rules MUST be adhered to or membership will be revoked. Any false statement contained in the membership application will be cause for immediate cancellation of said membership.

PROCESSING INFORMATION

IV. GUEST POLICY -

Pool Members are allowed up to 10 guests per day, per membership. All guests must pay the appropriate daily fee based on his/her age.

V. NANNY MEMBERSHIP

(Only available in conjunction with Family Membership):

Nanny Membership (Individual) \$125.00*
*plus Photo I.D. processing fee (per person) \$ 5.00

This option allows non-residents, who provide individual day care for children, to purchase an individual, non-park district, resident membership. In order for the day care provider to qualify, the child's family must purchase a family membership, and the day-care provider must present a written statement from an adult in the child's family.

VI. GROUP POLICY

A "Group Access" Permit is now required for use of TOB pool facilities by large groups. Contact the TOB Parks Department for an application at least three weeks prior to your first planned visit to the pool. Approval by the Parks Commissioner is required.

VII. REPLACEMENT PHOTO I.D. PASS:

Fee for lost or stolen Photo I.D. pass (per person) \$ 5.00



Registration will take place at Town of Oyster Bay Community Parks (Bethpage Community Park, Marjorie R. Post Community Park, Syosset-Woodbury Community Park and Plainview-Old Bethpage Community Park) beginning **Saturday, May 28, 2016** according to the following schedule:

FROM MAY 28 – JUNE 25, 2016:

Sundays, Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays

and Holidays: Noon – 6pm

Tuesdays and Thursdays: Noon – 7pm

STARTING JUNE 25, 2016:

During regular operating hours

Pool Memberships are good ONLY for the pool at which they are purchased.

When registering for the 2016 season, a new Photo I.D. pass must be purchased for each member. If lost, the member must pay for a new Photo I.D. pass.

Residents must come to the respective park in person.
Do Not Mail Information!

In order to register for the pool, all residents must provide the following:

a. Either a General Tax bill, deed **or** survey (**with section, block and lot**) or copy of lease agreement (with section, block and lot);

AND

b. A driver's license **or** current utility bill showing TOB address.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

• Birth Certificates must be shown for children 16 & under.

• Senior Citizens must show proof of age (60 and older).

(For a Senior Citizen married couple, only one spouse needs to be 60 or older.)

• Residents who live in condominiums or senior housing complexes must show appropriate proof of ownership.

Nanny Memberships

(only available in conjunction with a Family Membership)

In order for the individual Nanny to sign up, the following must be provided:

a. Driver's License/Photo ID

AND

b. A written declaration from an adult member of a family pass holder stating that he/she provides day care for child members of the family pass holder.
