**JOSEPH J. SALADINO MEMORIAL MARINA AT TOBAY BEACH
INSTRUCTION/INFORMATION SHEET**
Please review the information carefully

To obtain a TOBAY Entry Card, either in person or by mail, the following information must be supplied:

1. A completed and signed application form. Unsigned or incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant.
2. **Two** Proofs of residency:
 - a. A copy of your valid New York State Driver's license.
 - b. An **original** Town of Oyster Bay tax bill from 2016/2017. The tax bill must have the applicant's name and address or it is not acceptable proof. The bill will be returned to you. Renters may submit a notarized lease agreement, **plus** two utility bills – cable, phone, cell phone, etc. in the applicant's name. The section, block and lot must be obtained from your landlord and placed on the application.
3. **Two** Proofs of vessel ownership:
 - a. An **original** NYS Certificate of Title or Coast Guard Documentation.
 - Vessels 1987 and newer, at least 14 feet in length, unless documented, have been issued a NYS Certificate of Title. For vessels 1986 and older, the transferable registration is your title.
 - b. An **original** New York State Registration.
 - New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, Title 11, Article 48, Section 2251 requires all vessels in New York waters to be registered.
 - United States Coast Guard documentation cannot be used in place of a New York State vessel registration.
4. For vessels owned by Town of Oyster Bay residents born on or before October 31, 1957, a copy of your Town of Oyster Bay Senior Beach Identification Card.
5. Full payment, in either check or money order, made out to the Town of Oyster Bay. MasterCard, Visa, and Discover are only accepted in person.

Please note that additional information may be requested in order to issue the TOBAY Entry Card.

2017 SEASON FEES

TOBAY Entry Card

\$65.00 - one (1) to twenty-five (25) feet
\$75.00 - twenty-six (26) to thirty-one (31) feet
\$90.00 - over thirty-one (31) feet

- For vessels that are co-owned, the primary owner must be a Town of Oyster Bay resident. This means that their name and address must appear first on the registration and title/documentation.

- Vessels owned by a corporation will be permitted with legal proof of holdings (financial reports, corporate or tax documentation, etc.). This information, along with the above, must be submitted to the Division of Beaches to verify requirement satisfaction.
- Vessels leased from a valid Boat Yard or leasing company with the company or Boat Yard's name on the vessel's registration will be the only type of leased vessels eligible to receive a seasonal membership. A rental/lease agreement from company/Boat Yard must be included along with the above information.

Entrance Fee (without TOBAY Entry Card)

\$50.00 – Resident and Senior Resident

Daily Slip Rental

A. Monday through Friday excluding Holidays

\$15.00 per day - one (1) to twenty-five (25) feet
 \$20.00 per day - twenty-six (26) to thirty-one (31) feet
 \$25.00 per day - over thirty-one (31) feet

B. Senior - Monday through Friday excluding Holidays

\$ 7.50 per day - one (1) to twenty-five (25) feet
 \$10.00 per day - twenty-six (26) to thirty-one (31) feet
 \$15.00 per day - over thirty-one (31) feet

C. Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays

\$30.00 per day - one (1) to twenty-five (25) feet
 \$35.00 per day - twenty-six (26) to thirty-one (31) feet
 \$40.00 per day - over thirty-one (31) feet

- The **A dock** will be a flat rate of \$20.00, no TOBAY Entry Card required, per day or any portion thereof from dawn to dusk. No boats over 25 feet in length permitted and no overnight stays will be permitted.
- The senior citizen discount applies to a vessel that is owned by a person who was born on or before October 30, 1957. In order to obtain the discount, the Town of Oyster Bay Senior Beach ID card along with the TOBAY Entry Card must be shown to the dock master.

The official boating season will be from Saturday May 13, 2017 through September 24, 2017 and all Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays during the period of September 29, 2017 through October 29, 2017. The Marina will be closed during the Boat Show, dates to be determined.

For your convenience, the Beach Division office at Town Hall South will be open, in addition to the regular Monday through Friday 9:00 am to 4:30 pm hours:

Saturday, May 6, 2017 – 10 am to 2pm
 Saturday, May 20, 2017, 10 am to 2pm
