The Town of Oyster Bay's Department of Community and Youth Services is pleased to announce the 45th Annual Rotational Art Exhibit Program.

The mission of the Rotational Art Exhibit Program is to present artwork directly to the public in the everyday spaces in which they live and work. This concept challenges the notion that in order to experience art, one must go to a gallery or a museum. Thanks to this innovative program, members of the Oyster Bay community have the opportunity to view artwork in places such as banks, restaurants, salons, car dealerships, shopping centers, libraries and government offices.

Our program's ever-expanding roster proudly includes artists who work in a variety of styles and media. In past seasons, we have exhibited works from the fields of painting, drawing, photography, sculpting, weaving, woodworking, pottery, jewelry-making and more!

So, whether you are an artist looking for exposure for your artwork or a business looking to bring culture and interest to your environment, we've got the perfect solution for you!

The Rotational Art Exhibit Program seeks to link a new artist to each venue each month and, best of all, participation is free for both artists and businesses!

Eligibility

- Only framed or clean gallery edge works will be accepted.
- Works containing nudity will **not** be accepted.
- The Town of Oyster Bay (and the venue) retain the right to limit the display of any work deemed inappropriate or controversial.
- Sculpture and Crafts are limited to pieces that will fit into cases.
- Only original work, completed within the last five (5) years will be accepted.
- Artists will retain the right to limit the number of exhibits in which they wish to participate.

Step II: Preview

- The PREVIEW will take place on **Thursday, November 1, 2018** at the Syosset-Woodbury Community Center (7800 Jericho Turnpike, Woodbury, NY 11797).
- Artists are required to submit to the PREVIEW three (3) framed or mounted pieces with finished edges in the same media, no larger than 41"x 48."
- Artwork must be dropped off between 6:00 PM and 7:30 PM and picked up at 9:00 PM.
- Artwork will be reviewed by a judge.
- Artists will be notified via email if they have been accepted into the 2019 Rotational Art Exhibit Program.

Step III: Showcase

- The SHOWCASE will take place on **Friday, November 16, 2018** from 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM at the Hicksville Public Library (169 Jerusalem Avenue, Hicksville, NY 11801).
- Local merchants, library personnel and bank managers from various venues will have the opportunity to view and select your artwork.
- Artists may begin to hang their work in the space provided beginning at 12:00 PM. All work must be hung no later than 1:30 PM.
- There is a **mandatory** artist information meeting prior to the SHOWCASE at 1:30 PM.
- Artist must bring the three pieces previously viewed, but may also bring photos, catalogs, etc. of other work.
- Artwork may remain on view at the library throughout the month of November.
