A transient boat basin situated in South Oyster Bay via the TOBAY heading. Facilities are restricted to Town of Oyster Bay resident boat owners or lessee of boats who submit proof of ownership and residency. Non-residents permitted non-holiday weekdays only.

Residents who are frequent visitors can purchase a membership card for discounted pricing at the Beach office, located at Town Hall South, 977 Hicksville Road, Massapequa, during normal business hours.

### Required Documents for Boat Basin Entry Card:

- Driver's License
- TOB Tax Bill or 2 Utility Bills
- Valid NYS boat registration
- Boat Title or USCG Documentation

## North Shore Beaches

### Centre Island Beach, Bayville (residents & non-residents)

Swimming in Oyster Bay Harbor and Long Island Sound. Picnic tables available on bayside. Outdoor showers/bathrooms available.

### Charles E. Ransom Beach, Bayville (residents & non-residents)

No Swimming. Long Island Sound Overlook. Scenic views. New waterfront over-sized playground area and picnic benches.

### Stehli Beach, Bayville (residents only)

Swimming in Long Island Sound. Bathrooms.

### Harry Tappen Beach, Glenwood Landing (residents & non-residents)

Swimming in Hempstead Harbor, waterfront dining with to-go window, picnic area, kayak racks, marina, boat launching ramps, new waterfront playground, salt-water swimming pool, in-line roller hockey rink, half-court basketball and bathrooms.

### Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Beach, Oyster Bay (residents only)

Swimming in Oyster Bay Harbor, covered gazebo, concession stand, two covered picnic areas, tennis courts, handball and basketball courts, children's playground areas, picnic tables, marina, boat launching ramps, dingy/kayak racks, multiple bathroom facilities and scenic walking paths throughout

## South Shore Beaches

### Phillip B. Healey Beach at Florence Avenue, Massapequa (residents only)

Swimming in South Oyster Bay, playground, splash pad, picnic tables, and bathrooms.

### Tobay Beach, Massapequa (residents & non-residents)

Surfing/swimming in Atlantic Ocean, bayside swimming in South Oyster Bay, multiple concession stands, two waterfront restaurants, childrens spray park and playgrounds, 9/11 Memorial, transient boat basin, picnic tables, outdoor showers, multiple bathroom facilities, bike racks, and JFK Wildlife Bird Sanctuary.

# BEACH PARKING FEES & FAQS

## Residents

**Daily:** \$20 per day

*TOB resident must be in vehicle and show driver's license*

**Senior Citizen\*:** Free for residents 60 & older with a TOB Senior Beach ID Card. A seasonal sticker will not be placed on your vehicle. Senior residents must present Senior Beach ID Card upon entry.

**Seasonal Sticker:** \$60 per vehicle

*Eligible for vehicles registered within the Town of Oyster Bay*

Available for purchase at beach facilities and John J. Burns Park only

**Disabled/ Social Security\*:** Free for residents with a TOB Permanently Disabled Persons or SSC ID card. A seasonal sticker will not be placed on your vehicle. Residents must present Beach ID Card upon entry.

## Resident Discounted Seasonal Stickers

**VFD/AUX Police/USCG AUX/Active Military/Veterans:** \$30 with waiver obtained from Beach Division

*Must bring Fireman ID, DD214, military ID, AUX Coast Guard ID, or AUX Police ID with vehicle registration to Beach Division*

**Clean Pass Vehicles\*:** Free for vehicles classified as Clean Pass with waiver obtained from Town Clerk Office

## Replacement Beach Stickers

### Returned leased vehicle or selling a vehicle:

Before returning your vehicle, please remove the sticker from the vehicle and place the pieces in a safe place. Bring your new vehicle with the same license plate and the original sticker pieces to the location you purchased it from and they will issue you a replacement.

### Long term vehicle repairs or accident:

Please bring the following items to the Beach Division for a temporary pass:

- 1) Letter from mechanic stating the vehicle is currently in their possession, anticipated time of completion, and identifying the vehicle by make, model, and license plate
- 2) Photo of the sticker on the vehicle
- 3) Information for temporary vehicle.



# BEACH PARKING FEES & FAQs

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How do I obtain a seasonal beach sticker?

Bring the vehicle you would like the sticker placed on with the vehicle registration and payment to any Beach facility or John J. Burns Park Boat Ramps. Beach stickers are not available at any Town Hall facility.

### How do I obtain a Senior Beach ID Card?

Senior Beach ID cards, available to residents 60 and older, can be obtained at the Town Clerk’s office for a one-time fee of \$30.00, plus \$2.00 photo fee. This card entitles seniors to free daily parking permit and free seasonal trailer stickers for as long as they live within the Town of Oyster Bay.

### What if my car is registered to my job? Can I still get a sticker?

Yes. Special waiver forms are available at the Town of Oyster Bay Town Clerk’s office and at the Parks Department’s Beach Division. You are required to bring a letter from your employer, on company letterhead, stating that the company car is your primary vehicle, along with your proof of residency (tax bill, utility bills) and your driver’s license.

### I have dual residences, can I get a sticker?

Yes. Just bring the car registration, your driver’s license and proof of residency (tax bill or 2 utility bills) to either the Town Clerk’s office or the Parks Department’s Beach Division to obtain a special waiver.

## Permits

### The John F. Kennedy Memorial Wildlife Sanctuary at TOBAY

Free for all residents and non-residents. The sanctuary is a 550-acre stretch of protected wetlands. It is open year-round, but visitation hours are limited during June, July and August until after 6PM. A permit is required, which may be obtained through the Beach Division. You may apply in person or by mailing in your application. The application is available on our website.

### Night Surf Fishing Permit

These permits are free for all Town of Oyster Bay residents looking to fish at Town of Oyster Bay beaches between the hours of 7PM and 7AM. The application is available at our office or on our website. Please provide vehicle registration and NYS Marine Fishing License.
