Notice of Shellfishing Restriction - Revised

1. Conservation Management Area 1 – Oyster Bay Harbor adjacent to West Shore Road south of the Bayville Bridge – 25 acres: Coordinates 40.885151, - 73.546077; 40.886299,-73.543195; 40.882209, -73.544047, 40.883356, -73541165 – **Closed to all shellfishing: October 2, 2019 through November 1, 2019.**
2. Conservation Management Area 2 – East of and adjacent to Laurel Hollow Beach – 20 Acres: Coordinates 40.876619, -73.487969; 40.878222, -73.486267; 40.87622, -73.482997; 40.874618, -73.4847 – **The southernmost four acres of the conservation management area 40.875138, -73.485524 40.876727, -73.483866; 40.87622, -73.482997; 40.874618, -73.4847 are closed to shellfishing effective Saturday, September 21, 2019.**
3. Conservation Management Area 3 - Oyster Bay Cove, west of and adjacent to Lloyd Neck Beach – 10 acres: Coordinates 40.882575, -73.510405; 40.880396, -73.508943;-73.507379, 40.880965; 73508842, 40.883172 – **No Current Restrictions.**
4. Conservation Management Area 4 – Great South Bay: *All that area of South Oyster Bay, including tributaries, creeks and canals, lying north of a line extending easterly from the northeasternmost point of land of Great Island (west of Great Island Channel and south of The Run) to the southeasternmost point of land of Goose Island (southwest of Massapequa Creek); thence continuing easterly to a point of intersection located 900 yards southeast of Unqua Point (Nassau Shores), immediately north of old Winnehook Channel (local name); and continuing easterly to a point of intersection located 900 yards southwest of Bergen point (Great South Bay, Town of Babylon).* **NYSDEC Uncertified Waters, Closed to all shellfishing.**
