Dear Customer:

PSEG Long Island is beginning a scheduled project that will improve electric reliability for you and thousands of other customers in your community.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Assistance Program has provided funding to strengthen the electric grid in your area to better withstand extreme weather and allow for faster power restoration. This project will target the most vulnerable sections of the system, with a focus on replacing existing poles and related equipment.

All work will be completed by PSEG Long Island crews or our licensed and approved contractors.

Project Description and Benefits


This project will storm-harden main sections of the system that feed power to other electric wires in your community. Specifically, we will:

- Upgrade and replace existing electric wire with more weather-resistant wire.
- Install new and more durable poles. The new poles will typically be placed about two-to-three feet from current pole locations. Removing old poles requires action from all utilities that have installed equipment on the pole. To expedite this process, PSEG Long Island will actively coordinate with the cable TV and telephone utilities, as well as local municipalities.
- Install and/or replace switches, which can reroute power to reduce the number and severity of power outages.

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Facts about PSEG Long Island's FEMA Electric Circuit Improvement Project *Town of Oyster Bay*

PSEG Long Island is committed to delivering best-in-class system reliability to our customers and to hardening the system to better withstand extreme weather like Superstorm Sandy. Strengthening key electric circuits in your neighborhood will improve the reliability of the electric grid for thousands of our customers. We are working closely with local officials on this project, keeping them informed and working to minimize potential disruptions.

Funding from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

This project is funded through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance Program, which was established to harden electrical distribution infrastructure against future storm damage and help restore power more quickly.

Project Description and Benefits

Specifically, we will:

- Replace existing wire with more weather-resistant wire
- Install new and more durable poles in several locations
- Install and/or replace switching equipment to help reduce the number of customers affected by an outage

Project Route

The route will cover approximately 1.3 miles along an electric main line circuit. PSEG Long Island crews will be working on the following streets in Jericho in the Town of Oyster Bay:

- Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) between Jericho Quadrangle and Merry Lane
- Merry Lane between Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) and 4 Merry Lane
- Rear Property on the south side of Merry Lane between 4 Merry Lane and Hazelwood Drive
- Rear property on the west side of Hazelwood Drive between Merry Lane and Birchwood Park Drive
- Rear property between 235 Birchwood Park Drive and 239 Birchwood Park Drive
- Rear property between 26 and 42 Birchwood Park Crescent continuing along rear property right-of-way to LIE North Service Road

The main line electric wires will be moved underground to bypass rear properties along the following streets:

- Hazelwood Drive between Maiden Lane and Merry Lane
- Merry Lane between Hazelwood Drive and Maytime Drive
- Maytime Drive between Merry Lane and Leisure Street
- Leisure Street between Maytime Drive and Forest Drive
- Forest Drive between Leisure Street and Birchwood Park Drive
- Birchwood Park Drive between Forest Drive and Robbins Lane
- Robbins Lane from approximately 100 feet west of Birchwood Park Drive and Birchwood Park Drive

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- Leisure Street between Maytime Drive and Forest Drive
- Forest Drive between Leisure Street and Birchwood Park Drive
- Birchwood Park Drive between Forest Drive and Robbins Lane
- Robbins Lane from approximately 100 feet west of Birchwood Park Drive and Birchwood Park Drive

This will storm-harden a main line circuit serving hundreds of customers in the area, while allowing the utility poles and overhead secondary electric wires in rear properties to continue connecting these residents to the energy grid.

In addition, switching equipment will be installed or replaced at:

- Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) west of Simpson Street
- Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) west of Merry Lane

When will the work take place?

PSEG Long Island crews will generally work Monday – Saturday, 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., with limited evening and Sunday work. No work will be done on major national holidays.

Who is doing the actual work?

PSEG Long Island licensed and approved contractors.

Will the project include tree trimming?

Trees growing near power lines significantly increase the chance of power outages and pose safety risks. As we expand and improve our electric circuits, we will trim trees, where necessary, following our utility best practice model (ANSI A300 standards as well as the Best Management Practices Tree Pruning publication): 8 feet to each side; 12 feet above; and 10 feet below the conductor.

What size and where will the poles be located?

The new poles will be approximately the same height as existing poles, have a stronger base and will be placed about two-to-three feet from the current pole locations. PSEG Long Island will actively coordinate the removal of old poles with other utilities and municipalities.

Will there be any traffic interruptions?

There will be minor traffic interruptions related to this work. To ensure traffic moves safely, PSEG Long Island licensed and approved contractors will provide cones, flagmen and signage at the work site, as needed, to minimize interruptions.

Will there be any power outages?

PSEG Long Island anticipates some localized, intentional, short-duration power outages related to this project. All affected customers will be notified in advance of any power outage.

What is the timeline for the project?

This project will start in June 2017 and will take approximately five months to complete.
