

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Oyster Bay, Nassau County, State of New York invites Sealed Proposals with respect to the award of:

REPAIRS TO THE HICKSVILLE PARKING FACILITY

CONTRACT NO. H17-159R

BID NO. PW028R-18

Said proposals are to be received and stamped by the Division of Purchase and Supply of the Town of Oyster Bay at Town Hall West, 74 Audrey Avenue, 4TH Floor, Oyster Bay, New York, 11771-1592, not later than 11:00 a.m., prevailing time on **Monday, July 16, 2018** and, immediately thereafter, all proposals, bids and bid securities will be publicly opened and read aloud in the area as designated at Town Hall. The Town will then determine the apparent low bidder and for that bidder publicly open and read aloud the separate sealed envelope containing the subcontractors list.

Contract documents are available for review and procurement at the Division of Purchase and Supply of the Town of Oyster Bay at Town Hall West, 74 Audrey Avenue, 4TH Floor, Oyster Bay, New York, 11771-1592, on or after **Friday, June 15, 2018** between the hours 9:00 a.m. and 4:45 p.m., on regular business days, Monday through Friday. A charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) payable to the Town of Oyster Bay, non-refundable, will be required for the set of contract documents. In submitting a proposal hereunder, a Contractor is required to comply with all applicable provisions of Federal, State and Local Laws.

A mandatory pre-bid walk-through will be held at the project site on Friday, June 29, 2018, 10:00am for Contractors to view the project site with representatives of the Department of Public Works. Contract documents will not be available for procurement after the close of business day on Thursday, June 28, 2018.

In accordance with Town policy, the Contractor on this project must have an apprenticeship program(s) in effect, appropriate for the type and scope of the work to be performed, approved by the New York State Commissioner of Labor, prior to entering into a construction Contract with the Town of Oyster Bay. All Subcontractors, on subcontracts of \$250,000.00 or greater, must have an apprenticeship program(s) in place prior to the performance of any work on this project. If there are two or more subcontracts awarded by the General Contractor, involving one trade, and said subcontracts total \$250,000.00 or greater, then all such Subcontractors must have an apprenticeship program(s) in place prior to the performance of any work on this Contract.

At the time of bid submission, the Contractor and Subcontractor(s) shall submit with its bid proof of participation in a registered and approved NYS Apprenticeship Training Program in accordance with the Town's Rules and Regulations. If the Contractor does not submit the required affidavit and proof of participation in an Apprenticeship Training Program, the Town may declare the Contractor's bid non-responsive and award the contract to the next lowest responsible bidder.

In accordance with Section 220 of the New York Labor Law, all public works contracts in excess of \$250,000.00 require that all laborers, workers and mechanics working on the site be certified as having successfully completed the OSHA 10-hour construction safety and health course.

A Project Labor Agreement ("PLA") will be utilized for the Project. However, Bidders are reminded that this procurement remains subject to the applicable provisions of Article 5-A, Section 101(5) of the General Municipal Law regarding the submission of a separate sealed list of the names of the subcontractors/firms performing the Electrical; Plumbing; Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning and the agreed upon amount to be paid to each subcontractor as set forth in such Article. The name of the subcontractor/firm and supplier for the Carbon Fiber Reinforced Polymer and the names of any other subcontractors and suppliers intended for use on the project must also be submitted. Please see Section 24 of the Information for Bidders for further detail.

Subject to the foregoing, the availability of funds, and prevailing lawful requirements, the Town will award the contract to the lowest responsible qualified bidder.
