SUPERVISOR SALADINO: Good morning.

MR. DARIENZO: Good morning,
Supervisor and members of the Town board.
My name is Rob Darienzo. I'm the Town's
Director of Finance. I'm here to talk to
you today about the proposed preliminary
budget for the Town of Oyster Bay.

Our Town has earned great
recognitions for its financial
stewardship, finest services, and quality
of life. Under this administration, we
have earned 10 Wall Street credit rating
upgrades and they recognized our record
reduction of debt by \$185 million during
that timeframe, despite strict spending
restraints, innovative efficiencies and
aggressive debt reduction initiatives,
high interest costs, and the worst
inflation in four decades that have
driven up labor costs, healthcare
expenses and the price of nearly every
good in service; and yet, we've frozen

1
2 property taxes for seven straight years
3 after having cut them in the 2018 budget.
4 Most concerning state mandated rate hikes
5 for employees and retiree healthcare
6 premiums have skyrocketed from \$30
7 million to a projected \$50 million in
8 2026, an increase of more than 66%.

9 The 2026 Preliminary Budget
10 continues to ensure important
11 infrastructure investments can be made
12 through road repaving, sports field
13 improvements, park enhancements and the
14 costly annual rebuilding of TOBAY Beach.

15 The bottom line, this budget serves
