**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Annual Election of the Locust Valley Fire District will take place on December 13, 2016 between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Locust Valley Fire House located at 228 Buckram Road, Locust Valley, New York, for the purpose of electing one (1) Commissioner for a five (5) year term, commencing January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2021. All voters registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections on or before November 18, 2016 shall be eligible to vote.

Candidates for Fire District Office shall have filed their names in petition form with the Secretary of the Locust Valley Fire District, at the firehouse, 228 Buckram Road, Locust Valley, New York, no later than twenty days (20) before the election (November 23, 2016).

No absentee ballots shall be accepted.

**SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE LOCUST VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT  
DECEMBER 13, 2016**

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the General Municipal Law of the State of New York that a Special Election of the Locust Valley Fire District will take place on

December 13, 2016, between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M., prevailing time, at the Locust Valley Firehouse, 228 Buckram Road, Locust Valley, New York, for the purpose of voting on the following proposition.

All resident of the Locust Valley Fire District who were duly registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections on or before November 18, 2016, shall be entitled to vote on this election.

### **PROPOSITION #1**

Shall the Length of Service Award Program (a defined benefit program under New York State General Municipal Law Section 219) administered by the Locust Valley Fire District, be amended, effective March 1, 2017.

AMENDMENTS OF LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM (LOSAP) FOR THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OF THE LOCUST VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT AND LOCUST VALLEY FIRE DEPARTMENT, WILL (1) REDUCE THE ENTITLEMENT AGE OF ELIGIBLE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS TO 60 YEARS OF AGE FROM THE CURRENT 65 YEARS OF AGE; AND (2) ALLOW ELIGIBLE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS TO CONTINUE IN ACTIVE SERVICE AFTER REACHING ENTITLEMENT AGE, AND TO ACCRUE PROGRAM POINTS AND RECEIVE A PROGRAM CONTRIBUTION, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST TO THE LOCUST VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT FOR LOSAP INCLUDING THE ADOPTION OF SAID AMENDMENTS SHALL BE APPROXIMATELY \$279,000.00 IN 2017; \$332,000.00 PER YEAR FOR THE SUBSEQUENT FOUR (4) YEARS; AND APPROXIMATELY \$245,000 PER YEAR FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER. THE CURRENT ANNUAL COST OF LOSAP IS APPROXIMATELY \$200,000.00 PER YEAR.
