2023 NIGHT FISHING

Free for Town of Oyster Bay Residents (\$50 processing fee for Non-Residents) looking to fish at a Town of Oyster Bay beach between the hours of 7PM and 7AM. Night fishing is permitted at the following locations, during the following dates:

January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023

Harry Tappen Beach (Glenwood Landing)

Theodore Roosevelt Beach (Oyster Bay)

Centre Island Beach (Bayville)

May 1, 2023 through December 12, 2023

TOBAY Beach (Massapequa)

Non-residents will be able to obtain a Night Fishing pass by submitting a \$50 fee and being sponsored by a current Town resident who has obtained a permit. Each resident with a current Night Fishing permit will be able to sponsor **ONE** non-resident, and will be held responsible for the non-resident's decorum while using Town facilities. Permits expire at the end of the year, applicants must reapply annually. Permits will be mailed once processed, please allow 5 to 10 business days for your physical permit(s) to arrive in the mail. Parking passes must be displayed on dashboards while parking in Town lots where night fishing is permitted.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Browse to <https://web1.myvscloud.com/wbwc/nyoysterbaywt.wsc/login.html>
2. Sign in with your username or create an account. (If you do not know your password, use the **FORGOT PASSWORD** link to reset your password using your email on file).
3. After signing in, click on the "Beach Permits & Applications" tile and select Night Fishing Permit.
4. Upload the required documents (see list below) using the upload form.
5. The Parks Department will receive notification of your uploaded documents. Permits will be mailed once processed, please allow 5 to 10 business days for your physical permit(s) to arrive in the mail. Parking passes must be displayed on dashboards while parking in Town lots.

The following documents **MUST** be upload to your online Parks Portal account:

- Copy of a Valid NYS Driver's License (P.O. Box NOT accepted)
- NYS Vehicle Registration (Temporary registrations NOT accepted)
- NYS Recreational Marine Fishing Registration Card
- Current year Town of Oyster Bay Tax Bill AND ONE Utility Bill; Renters may submit a notarized lease agreement AND TWO utility bills (Residents ONLY)
- Copy of resident sponsor's permit (Non-residents ONLY)

ALL CREDENTIALS MUST MATCH THE NAME AND ADDRESS ON THE APPLICANT'S DRIVERS LICENSE
