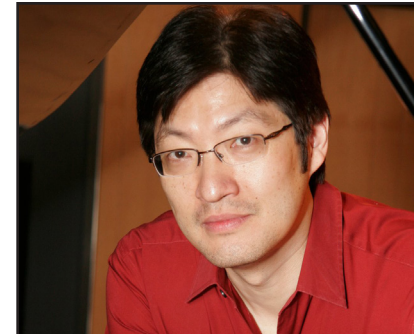

Seaford/Oyster Bay Expressway (Rte. 135) to Exit 8, Powell Avenue. Turn right (west) onto Powell Avenue. Library is ahead on the left.

116 Merritts Road  
Farmingdale, NY 11735

Seaford/Oyster Bay Expressway (Rte. 135) to Exit 7E, Rte. 24 (Hempstead Tpke.) Go east on Hempstead Turnpike to Merritts Road. Turn right on Merritts Road. Library is 1 1/2 blocks ahead on the right.
