BAYVILLE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

34 School Street, Bayville.....(516) 628-1720/1439 Museum housed, in part, in the only remaining building complex that was part of the Harrison Williams 88-acre "Oak Point" estate. It features several rooms of exhibits depicting Bayville's history.

COLD SPRING HARBOR FISH HATCHERY & AQUARIUM

1660 Rte. 25A, Cold Spring Harbor.....(516) 692-6768 Non-profit educational center dedicated to educating visitors about freshwater ecosystems of New York. Educational programs available to public and school groups throughout the year.

COLD SPRING HARBOR LABORATORY

1 Bungtown Road, Cold Spring Harbor(516) 367-8800 Private, non-profit institution with research programs in cancer, neuroscience, plant genetics, genomics and bioinformics. Regularly scheduled free Community Tours during spring and fall; reservations required.

EARLE-WIGHTMAN HOUSE

20 Summit Street, Oyster Bay(516) 922-5032 Circa 1720 building restored and maintained by the Town of Oyster Bay, it is the home of the Oyster Bay Historical Society and houses a collection of Town memorabilia.

GARVIES POINT MUSEUM & PRESERVE

McLaughlin Ave & Garvies Point Road, Glen Cove (516) 571-8010 Sixty-two-acre preserve includes 11 marked trails and features geologic specimens native to Long Island. Museum depicts early Native American culture and geologic history of Long Island through dioramas, charts and models.

HICKSVILLE GREGORY MUSEUM

Heitz Place Courthouse, Hicksville(516) 822-7505 Largest rock and mineral collection on Long Island along with more than 5,000 butterfly and moth specimens is housed in the historic Hicksville Courthouse ca. 1895. Courses offered in earth and natural sciences and Long Island history, as well as lectures, workshops and field trips.

HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL & TOLERANCE CENTER

100 Crescent Beach Road, Glen Cove,(516) 571-8040 The Holocaust Memorial and Tolerance Center of Nassau County showcases the history of the Holocaust and its lessons through education and community outreach. Its mission focuses on teaching about the dangers of anti-Semitism, intolerance, racism, bullying, and all other manifestations of bigotry. HMTC is a sanctuary for all people, regardless of their faith or ethnicity.

JOHN F. KENNEDY MEMORIAL WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

OLD BETHPAGE VILLAGE RESTORATION

SEA CLIFF VILLAGE MUSEUM

95 10th Avenue, Sea Cliff.....(516) 801-3401 Housed in a former Methodist parsonage, the museum focuses on the history of Sea Cliff. It contains an extensive photo collection, a costume exhibit, artifacts, documents and gift shop and sponsors special programs and exhibits.

THEODORE ROOSEVELT SANCTUARY AND AUDUBON CENTER

Cove Road, Oyster Bay.....(516) 922-3200 Owned by the National Audubon Society, the sanctuary contains 12 acres of unspoiled land and a self-guiding nature trail. Museum houses Long Island flora and fauna exhibits. Adjacent to Young's Cemetery, final resting place of Theodore Roosevelt.

TACKAPAUSHA MUSEUM AND PRESERVE

Washington Avenue, Seaford.....(516) 572-0200 Eighty-acre preserve with five miles of lush trails and many live animals. Guided tours (school children only) available.

WATERFRONT CENTER

Important Safety Reminders

Hurricane/Tropical Storm Preparation & Safety Tips

Hurricane Season Runs June 1st - November 30th

Assemble a 'Go-Kit' for family and pets with food and supplies.

Move vehicles away from flood-prone areas.

Make arrangements for temporary shelter for pets in the event of evacuation.

Do Not tape glass windows with an X, but do close curtains.

Have battery-operated lanterns on hand with extra batteries. Do not use candles.

Charge your cell phone and check fire extinguishers and smoke detectors.

Fuel vehicles and back-up generators, adjust refrigerators to coldest settings.

Store all lawn and patio objects that could blow away.

Stay away from downed utility wires - they may be live and cause harm.

Keep coolers filled with ample ice/frozen bottled water.

Place important papers in a waterproof container or in a safe deposit box.

Check with elderly neighbors or shut-ins. Set up a buddy system to assist them.

Hold a family meeting to discuss evacuation procedures.

Take photos/video of your property before and after the storm. Visit the National Hurricane Center at Hurricanes.gov

Never use a generator indoors and keep it at least 20 feet away from your home.

Purchase flood insurance and conduct an insurance check-up.

If an evacuation of coastal areas is ordered, evacuate immediately. High tides and strong winds may cause early flooding and make low-lying roads impassable. Pay attention to potential hazards and impacts, NOT the category of the storm. Water is the chief cause of death in a tropical cyclone. Learn the best evacuation route before a storm forms. Make arrangements to stay with friends or relatives inland until the storm has passed and don't forget to take your "Disaster Supply Kit."

- Tune your NOAA Weather Radio to 162.550 MHZ for up-to-the-minute National Weather Service forecasts, warnings and more, 24-hours a day.

Snow Storm Preparation & Safety Tips

Please help our Snow Crew help you! The Town Highway Department is prepared with over 25,000 tons of salt and sand and pretreats roadways before the start of a storm to reduce icing.

Plowing operations - including a snow-fighting fleet of about 300 pieces of equipment - get underway once an accumulation of 2-3 inches of snow is on the ground. Anything less is treated with salt and sand.

Please Move Your Cars Off The Street!

Whether you move your cars into your driveway, ask a neighbor for permission to use theirs or park temporarily on the sidewalk, it is vital that streets are clear of cars for proper curb to curb plowing.

Do not Blow or Shovel Snow into the Street

Please be considerate of how and where you pile your snow when shoveling or using a snowblower. Always shovel snow or aim a snowblower chute back onto your property.

Clear Sidewalks, Fire Hydrants & Street Drains

Safety is key. Please dig out any fire hydrants and street drains on or near your property. Clear your sidewalks of snow to ensure it is safe for pedestrians. Please be careful. Over exhaustion can lead to serious health risks.

We Appreciate Your Patience

Please don't take it personally if plows push snow back into your driveway. This is unavoidable due to the design of every snowplow. Stagger your shoveling or wait until the plows have passed. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.
