IV. GUEST POLICY

TOB Residents are allowed up to 10 guests per day. All guests must pay the appropriate daily fee based on his/her membership/residency/age.

V. NANNY MEMBERSHIP

(Only available in conjunction with Family Membership):

Nanny Membership (Individual)

\$150

This option allows non-residents, who provide individual day care for children, to purchase an individual, non-park district, resident membership. In order for the day care provider to qualify, the child's family must purchase a family membership, and the day-care provider must present a written statement from an adult in the child's family.



Processing Information

Registration for Town of Oyster Bay Residents will take place at Town of Oyster Bay Community Parks (Bethpage Community Park, Marjorie R. Post Community Park, Syosset-Woodbury Community Park and Plainview-Old Bethpage Community Park) beginning **Saturday, May 16, 2026** according to the following schedule:

FROM MAY 16 – JUNE 26, 2026:

Sundays, Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays: Noon – 6pm
Tuesdays and Thursdays: Noon – 7pm

STARTING JUNE 27, 2026:

During regular operating hours

Pool Memberships are good for ANY TOB pool.

TOB Residents must come to the respective park in person.
Do Not Mail Information!

In order to register for the pool, all residents must provide the following:

a. Either a General Tax bill, deed **or** survey (**with section, block and lot**)
or copy of lease agreement (with section, block and lot);

AND

b. A driver's license **or** current utility bill showing TOB address.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

• *Birth Certificates must be shown for all children in the family unit.*

• *Senior Citizens must show proof of age (60 and older).*

(For a Senior Citizen married couple, only one spouse needs to be 60 or older.)

• *TOB Residents who live in condominiums or senior housing complexes must show appropriate proof of ownership.*

Nanny Memberships

(only available in conjunction with a *Family Membership*)

In order for the individual Nanny to sign up, the following must be provided:

a. Driver's License/Photo ID

AND

b. A written declaration from an adult member of a family pass holder stating that he/she provides day care for child members of the family pass holder.

Rules and Regulations

1. THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) who is responsible for the children and their behavior while at the pool.
2. A person must be 16 years of age or older to join as an individual member.
3. A “family” is defined as a married couple or single parent and all unmarried children residing at the same address.
4. Bathers must wear swimsuits and/or proper pool attire at all times while on the pool deck. Street shoes are not permitted on the pool deck.
5. Bathers are required to take showers before entering the pool.
6. Anyone wearing diapers in the pool must have a water repellent covering over them.
7. Persons using the pool, diving boards and other amenities must be capable and qualified to do so. Skill level, age and physical condition are factors to be considered. Lifeguards on duty reserve the right to make any final determinations.
8. In case of an emergency, notify the facility operator and contact help as soon as possible.
9. The following are prohibited in the pool area: ball playing of any type, pushing, running, dunking or boisterous conduct, toys, play equipment, swim fins, masks, glassware or breakables of any kind, radios, sun tan lotions or oils, and dressing or undressing, except in designated areas. Permitted flotation devices are limited to those sewn into the suit or labeled U.S. Coast Guard approved. No flotation devices with clips, buckles, belts, inflatables, etc. will be allowed.
10. Smoking and consumption of alcohol are PROHIBITED at all Town of Oyster Bay Parks, including pools.
11. EATING ON THE POOL DECK IS PROHIBITED, except in designated areas.
12. The Commissioner of Parks, or his designee, may adopt additional rules, regulations and hours of operation that he/she finds to be in the best interest of, or necessary for the safety of, the public.
13. The pool may be used only during posted hours of operation.
14. All rules MUST be adhered to or membership will be revoked. Any false statement contained in the membership application will be cause for immediate cancellation of said membership.

Town of Oyster Bay Community Park Swim Lessons

Classes are taught by American Red Cross Certified Lifeguards. Registration will be ONLINE beginning Tuesday, May 26, 2026 at oysterbaytown.com/portal. Children must be 5 years of age or older to participate. For each session, classes are held weekdays for two weeks. Classes begin at 11:15am, 12:15pm, 3:15pm, or 4:15pm and last 45 minutes. The registration fee is \$75 per child.



First Session: June 29th to July 10th

Second Session: July 13th to July 24th

Third Session: July 27th to August 7th

Fourth Session: August 10th to August 21st
