and then a CVS. Directly to the south		
opposite Platia on Cold Spring Road is a		
gas station, so you can see the area's		
developed pretty much commercially only.		

Some background: In the beginning of 2018, the principal of Platia enclosed a patio area which had like a knee wall and a surface area patio and created a 7.5ft by 46 foot addition which was 345ft<sup>2</sup> without obtaining a building permit. Platia was issued a violation fine in March of 2019 for the interior alteration without the permit and the use and occupancy, and also because they had not yet obtained a public assembly license for that year.

That violation was resolved by a plea and a disposition subject to a conditional discharge. Platia pled guilty to a violation of Section 93-28 of the code for the interior alteration and paid a fine of \$900. The public assembly license violation was dismissed in
