The Town of Oyster Bay was awarded a \$8.7 Million grant for downtown Hicksville from New York State through the Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI) Program, whose goal is to transform "downtown neighborhoods into vibrant centers that offer a high quality of life and are magnets for redevelopment, business, job creation, and economic and housing diversity". The subject project shall consist of Festival Plaza (Project Profile C- modified), New Station Plaza (Project Profile B- modified) and The Underline (Project Profile E).

A virtual information session for the project will be on **Tuesday, October 11, 2022 at 10am**. While not mandatory, prospective proposers are encouraged to join. Credentials to access the videoconference will be provided to firms which obtain the RFP documents.
