The Town of Oyster Bay is committed to creating new job opportunities for residents and connecting qualified job seekers with employers. As part of this commitment, the Town serves as administrator of The Workforce Partnership, a consortium of local governments funded by the Federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act that provides valuable resources to both employers and job seekers. All services offered are free and offered in-person.

The Workforce Partnership Career Center locations are in Hicksville and Massapequa. These centers help grow our economy by training employees to meet the needs of the private sector, connecting qualified job seekers with employers, and by assisting applicants in accessing job opportunities. The Center offers Resource Rooms, which are equipped with state-ofthe-art computer workstations, complete with Microsoft software and internet access. Additionally, the Center offers residents access to job listings, resource materials, photocopiers, fax machines and telephones. The Center provides employability and computer workshops, as well as career counselors who will guide residents through their job search. Computer workshops are taught on-site in modern computer labs. Residents can increase their marketability by updating or acquiring new computer skills at the Center.

Interview Preparation & Counseling - As a job seeking customer of The Workforce Partnership, a Career Specialist can be assigned to assist you.

Skills Matching and Referral Technology - The NYS Department of Labor's Jobzone system searches your resume for details about you. It matches your information to the skills, experience and expertise employers say they want in candidates for job openings.

Job Placement Services - Matching job seekers with a variety of employment opportunities.

Job Banks - We maintain job listings for both private sector and civil service jobs. These listings are updated on a regular basis.

#### Workshops

**Computer Workshops** in Microsoft Office Suite to upgrade skills and gain basic computer knowledge.

**Social Media Workshops** for job seekers. Social media workshops include LinkedIn, Facebook and other sites to find employment.
