PUBLIC NOTICE

Following approved by vote at Board meeting held January 6, 2020.

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on May 6, 2019, the Locust Valley Fire District authorized the construction of the mezzanine storage area over the rear of the Tower Ladder Apparatus Bay in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, and that H2M Architects + Engineers, be directed to provide engineering services related to the structural analysis, design, preparing of detailed plans and specifications for subsequent bidding and construction of the mezzanine storage, including site investigation and inspection, and construction management, for an amount not to exceed \$15,000, all with funds available from the Building Reserve Account; and

WHEREAS, the cost estimates provided by H2M Architects and Engineers for the aforementioned project exceed the allotted budget and the Locust Valley Fire District seeks to increase the budget amount for construction in an amount not to exceed \$70,000, and for engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the amount to construct the mezzanine storage area over the rear of the Tower Ladder Apparatus Bay be increased for an amount not to exceed \$70,000, payable upon presentation of a duly certified claim, after audit, with funds available from the Building Reserve Account; and it be further

RESOLVED, that the amount for engineering services to be provided by H2M Architects and Engineers in connection with the mezzanine project be increased for an amount not to exceed \$30,000, payable upon presentation of a duly certified claim, after audit, with funds available from the Building Reserve Account; and it be further

RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized to enter into any contracts/agreements and to execute any other documentation necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum, as required by General Municipal Law.
