Public Notice

WHEREAS, the Locust Valley Fire District seeks to replace the existing 542 and acquire a pumper truck for the use in emergency response within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Locust Valley Fire District established an Equipment Reserve Account and set aside funds since 2005 in said account for the above stated purpose; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell, 202 12th Street NE, P.O. Box 219, Staples, MN 56479 is a government unit of the State of Minnesota which is authorized to contract with eligible entities and contractors for the purchase of goods and services, including a firematic apparatus and motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell has instituted a cooperative purchasing program, to serve as the designated purchasing agent, on behalf of participating end users, such as municipalities and fire districts, in connection with the competitive bidding process in the purchase of a firematic apparatus and motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is authorized to contract (Contract #113021-CSM) with Custom Fire Apparatus, Inc., 509 68th Avenue, Osceola, Wisconsin 54020 (Product Manufacturer), through Proliner Rescue, Inc., 18 Peconic Avenue, Medford, New York 11763, the authorized dealership representing Custom Fire Apparatus, Inc., for the sale of the abovementioned pumper truck; and

WHEREAS, through the Sourcewell, the Locust Valley Fire District seeks to purchase from Sourcewell, Custom Fire Apparatus, Inc. and Proliner Rescue, Inc., the Sourcewell MPCU Pumper built on a 2024 Metro Star 4-Door 4x4 chassis to include a Waterous CGVPA pump, 500-gallon water tank, CustomFIRE stainless steel bolted construction body with painted roll-up doors, NFPA optical and audible warning package and other features as per specifications submitted May 5, 2023 (the "Pumper Truck") for an amount not to exceed \$1,219,473.00, with a ten percent (10%) increase of \$121,947.30 for unforeseen regulatory changes and/or supply chain volatility surcharges, for a total amount of \$1,341,420.30, with funds payable from the Equipment Reserve Account; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 5-A Public Contracts of the New York State General Municipal Law, LVFD seeks to enter into an agreement with Sourcewell, Custom Fire Apparatus, Inc. and Proliner Rescue, Inc. for the purchase of the new Pumper Truck; and

WHEREAS, the Equipment Reserve Account has sufficient funds for the aforementioned purchase of the Pumper Truck and said purchase shall not result in the expenditure of any additional tax monies, nor increase in any tax levy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements with Sourcewell, Custom Fire Apparatus, Inc. and Proliner Rescue, Inc. for the purchase of the new Pumper Truck, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is authorized to make payment for the abovementioned Pumper Truck in the fire apparatus and related tools and equipment in the total amount not to exceed \$1,341,420.20, upon presentation of a duly certified claim forms, after audit, with funds available from the Equipment Reserve Account; and it be further

RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized to enter into any purchase contracts and to execute any other documentation necessary to facilitate the purchase of the new Pumper Truck; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum, as required by New York State General Municipal Law.
