This new initiative 19 increases our oversight of contractors and 20 departments and holding them more accountable for 2.1 things like cost overruns, while increasing 22 transparency. These new taxpayer protections are 23 designed to increase oversight, prevent waste, 2.4 fraud and abuse of tax dollars. 25 This new policy will help assure our

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taxpayers, the Town Board and our residents that all change orders that are necessary have been reviewed by the finance director, reviewed by the Town Comptroller and reviewed by the Inspector General, in addition to Town Board members.

Steve, I want to thank you for bringing this initiative, a great idea. I know you're experienced not only in the State Assembly, but you're experienced as the Chief Deputy Comptroller of Nassau County helped to identify this issue.

COUNCILMAN LABRIOLA: Well, thank you, Supervisor, and I thank my colleagues on the Board, assuming that they are all going to be voting for this, and I thank the Engineering Division, Public Works, Comptroller, the Inspector General and all our departments and attorneys who contributed to formulating or putting into place a written policy which, of course, much of which is already being followed by our Commissioner Lenz and, of course, he does a terrific job watching the taxpayer dollars and watching on our behalf.

I think what this does is simply give reassurance to the Board members and the taxpayers that their money is being watched extremely closely, and that when there are change orders and

17 cost overruns on Public Works jobs, that the work 1 2 was necessary and that the work was -- that a good 3 value for the dollar of the additional work, and I 4 think all that is very important when people 5 question how in which their dollars are being spent. This is all part and parcel of putting more 6 7 controls in place to make sure that Oyster Bay is 8 always moving forward and moving in the right 9 direction. 10 SUPERVISOR SALADINO: Thank you, 11 Councilman. 12 We appreciate your expertise and 13 additions to the legislation of this Town. 14 May we have a vote, please? 15 MR.
