At the regular meeting of the Locust Valley Fire District held August 13, 2018, the following resolution was acted upon:

**RESOLVED**

WHEREAS, the Locust Valley Fire District seeks to acquire certain radio communication equipment for the use in fire protection and emergency response within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Locust Valley Fire District established an Equipment Reserve Account and set aside funds in said account for the above stated purpose; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 5-A of General Municipal Law of the State of New York and in accordance with New York State Contract # PT67405, Radio Communications Equipment, the Locust Valley Fire District wishes to purchase the following:

**A total of thirty-five (35) units complete including:**

for the total amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, which shall be payable with funds to be drawn from the Equipment Reserve Account, upon submission of a duly certified claim form; and

WHEREAS, the Equipment Reserve Account has sufficient funds for the aforementioned purchase and said purchase shall not result in the expenditure of any additional tax monies, nor increase in any tax levy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for the abovementioned radio communications equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, upon presentation of a duly certified claim form, after audit, with funds available from the Equipment Reserve Account; and it be further

RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized to enter into any purchase contract and to execute any other documentation necessary to facilitate the purchase of the above mentioned radio communications equipment; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum, as required by General Municipal Law.
