

Locust Valley Fire District
Notice of Permissive Referendum

At the Regular Meeting of the Locust Valley Fire District held July 9, 2018, the following Resolution was passed as follows:

WHEREAS, since 2005 the Locust Valley Fire District set out on a plan to acquire certain fire apparatus/trucks, and related tools and equipment, for the use in fire protection and emergency response within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Locust Valley Fire District established an Equipment Reserve Account and set aside funds since 2005 in said account for the above stated purpose; and

WHEREAS, by previous resolution dated January 19, 2018, the Locust Valley Fire District was authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with HGACBuy, a cooperative purchasing program, to utilize its services in connection with the competitive bidding process for the purchase of the aforementioned fire apparatus/truck; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 26, 2018, the Locust Valley Fire District, through the HGACBUY program entered into an agreement with Firematic Supply Company, Inc., the authorized agent for Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., to purchase a Pierce Enforcer Side Mount Pumper; and

WHEREAS, that the purchase price for the Pierce Enforcer Side Mount Pumper shall not exceed \$735,000, which shall be payable with funds to be drawn from the Equipment Reserve Account, upon submission of a duly certified claim form; and

WHEREAS, the Equipment Reserve Account has sufficient funds for the aforementioned purchase and said purchase shall not result in the expenditure of any additional tax monies, nor increase in any tax levy; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the purchase and delivery of the Pierce Enforcer Side Mount Pumper, the Fire District shall trade-in to Firematic Supply Company, Inc. the existing Engine 544, the 1994 Spartan RD Murray 1500/500 Engine, and receive a trade-in value of \$12,000, payable by separate remittance to the Locust Valley Fire District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for Pierce Enforcer Side Mount Pumper, in an amount not to exceed \$735,000, upon presentation of a duly certified claim form, after audit, with funds available from the Equipment Reserve Account; and it be further

RESOLVED, That the Locust Valley Fire District is hereby authorized to enter into any purchase contract and to execute any other documentation necessary to facilitate the purchase of the Pierce Enforcer Side Mount Pumper; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum, as required by General Municipal Law.
