INLAND MARINE-ROLLING STOCK POLICY WITH FINE ARTS COVERAGE**

To Whom It May Concern:

On March 1, 2023, the Town's Inland Marine – Rolling Stock Policy w/Fine Arts Coverage comes up for renewal.

Our current policy is as follows:

<u>Contractors Equipment Limit</u>	\$50,000,000.00
Flood Sub-limit - X zones	\$ 5,000,000.00
Flood Sub-limit – all other zones	\$ 1,000,000.00
Fine Arts	\$ 1,357,620.00 - scheduled
Fine Arts Exhibition Floater - - Raynham Hall	\$100,000.00 Max Recovery \$15,000.00 per item

Deductibles:	\$ 25,000.00 per claim except Flood
	\$ 100,000.00 for X zones;
	\$ 250,000.00 for all other flood zones
	\$ 1,000.00 for Fine Arts and Exhibition Floater

We would prefer to keep the limits as outlined above, and will consider a multi-year policy in order to reduce our premiums. We do require that insurance companies providing coverage be rated no lower than "A" with a minimum size rating of 8 out of 15.


