

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

MASSAPEQUA FIRE DISTRICT,
IN THE TOWN OF OYSTER BAY,
NASSAU COUNTY, NEW YORK

MARCH 26, 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election of the qualified voters of the Massapequa Fire District (hereinafter called the "Fire District"), in the Town of Oyster Bay, Nassau County, New York, will be held within the Fire District, on Tuesday, March 26, 2019, at 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time), at the following voting locations, being the respective polling places for the Fire District's three (3) election districts: (1) West End Firehouse, located on the corner of Hicksville Road and Grand Avenue in Massapequa, New York; (2) East End Firehouse, located on the corner of Merrick Road and East Shore Drive in Massapequa; and (3) Massapequa Park Firehouse, located on the north side of Front Street between First and Second Avenues in Massapequa Park, New York. Registered voters will be permitted to vote at any of the foregoing locations. The voting at such Special Election shall be by voting machine and the polls shall remain open until 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) or as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their votes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Fire District on February 11, 2019, the following Proposition will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Fire District for approval or disapproval:

PROPOSITION

SHALL the bond resolution of Massapequa Fire District, in the Town of Oyster Bay, New York, entitled: "BOND RESOLUTION OF THE MASSAPEQUA FIRE DISTRICT ("FIRE DISTRICT"), IN THE TOWN OF OYSTER BAY, NASSAU COUNTY, NEW YORK, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 11, 2019, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION AND ALTERATIONS TO THE EXISTING PARK HOUSE FIRE STATION LOCATED AT 259 FRONT STREET, MASSAPEQUA PARK, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN A PLAN PREPARED FOR THE FIRE DISTRICT BY H2M ARCHITECTS + ENGINEERS, MELVILLE, NEW YORK, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF ORIGINAL FURNISHINGS, EQUIPMENT, MACHINERY OR APPARATUS AND ANY ANCILLARY OR RELATED SITE, DEMOLITION AND OTHER WORK REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH ("PROJECT"); STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS NOT TO EXCEED \$9,500,000, INCLUDING PRELIMINARY COSTS AND COSTS INCIDENTAL THERETO AND TO THE FINANCING THEREOF; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE FIRE DISTRICT IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$9,500,000 TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION; DETERMINING THAT THE PERIOD OF PROBABLE USEFULNESS OF SAID PROJECT IS FIFTEEN (15) YEARS; DETERMINING THAT, PURSUANT TO THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT ("SEQRA"), THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, ACTING AS LEAD AGENCY, HAS DETERMINED THAT THE PROJECT IS AN UNLISTED ACTION AND A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN ISSUED AND FILED AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES TO BE COLLECTED TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS," BE APPROVED?

All residents of the Fire District who were duly registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections on or before March 4, 2019, shall be eligible to vote at said Special Election.

The boundaries of the three (3) elections of the Fire District are as follows:

(1) West End Firehouse, Hicksville Road and Grand Avenue, in Massapequa, New York for voters residing in the election district, bounded on the west by the town line between the Town of Oyster Bay and the Town of Hempstead; on the north by Jerusalem Avenue, on the east by the Massapequa State Park and the Massapequa River; and on the south by the Great South Bay.

(2) East End Firehouse, Merrick Road and East Shore Drive in Massapequa, New York for voters residing in the election district, bounded on the west by Lake Shore Boulevard and the Massapequa River; on the north by the Long Island Railroad; on the east by County Line Road and the Narraskatuck River, and on the south by the Great South Bay.

(3) At the Massapequa Park Firehouse, north side of Front Street between First and Second Avenues, Massapequa Park, New York for voters residing in the election district, bounded on the west by Massapequa State Park, on the north by Southern State Parkway, the division line between the Massapequa Fire District and South Farmingdale Fire District; and on the east by the division line between Nassau County and Suffolk County; on the south by the Long Island Railroad.
